Level ground in campsite • Tent, kitchen area, fire pit, driveway, latrine close together • No steps • Fully-equipped kitchen includes water source, built-in sink, animal-proof food box • Adapted picnic table • Raised fire pit • Wider latrine with adaptations

The Beach and Boat Dock

The sandy beach and grassy lawn are where folks like to gather to swim (lifeguarded) and talk. The nearby boat area has row boats, canoes and life vests available for free.

The Barn... gift shop, conversation and jig saw puzzle central... and more! The barn has a social area, store and rest rooms. The upstairs is huge, and has basketball, volleyball and table tennis.

The Playground

(Photo, top left) A safe fun place for kids! Age-appropriate equipment includes slides, fireman's pole, climbing walls, swings, see-saws, and rope ladder. It's next to the swim beach.

The Crafts Area

Scheduled, supervised craft-making activities are here, under this sheltered facility. Great for kids and parents.

The Outdoor Chapel

Overlooks the lake. Seating for 30. Informal worship held each Sunday morning.
